Children will not be allowed to enter the building until 8:50 a.m. each morning. Please help your children time their arrival accordingly. Children who must arrive earlier need to be enrolled in our Child Care program. Please contact the office for more information.

To report your child's absence, please call our answering machine at **586-797-7399**. When you place your call please clearly state your child's name, teacher, reason for, and length of absence. The answering machine will take attendance calls 24 hours a day.

Lunch (11:50-1:25)

Students may either bring their own lunch to school or purchase a hot lunch. **Lunch w/ milk is \$2.75.** Students may purchase just milk for 45 cents. **Please review the monthly hot lunch menu on Beacon Tree's new web page under Parents—Food Service Menu with your child.** It is very important that students who wish to purchase hot lunch **order the day before.** New lunch schedule: Grades K-11:30-12:10, 2nd-11:35-12:15, 5th-11:55-12:35, 1st-12:00-12:40, 6th-12:25-1:05, 4th-12:50-1:30, 3rd-12:25-1:05. All students will eat lunch for 20 minutes before going out to lunch recess for 20 minutes.

We **STRONGLY** encourage you to apply online this year using this website. Please know that student lunches for students are available for free, or at a reduced price of 40 cents, for families that qualify based on family size and income.

Nut Safe Rooms

Should your child be placed in a nut safe room, there are a few simple things you can do to help us to ensure a safe environment for the student(s) with a nut allergy. A letter will be sent home the first day of school to outline those items. Most importantly we must require **no**

homemade bake or commercially prepared bakery treats to be brought to school.



Visitors

In accordance with school district policy, everyone entering Beacon Tree must report to the office. Our office staff will be glad to help you out. If you are volunteering you will need to sign in. All visitors will be given an identification badge to wear while inside Beacon Tree. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Recuperating at Home

When is your child too sick to attend school? The following guidelines, along with the advice of your family doctor, will help you decide when your child should stay home:

- Cold and/or cough – a child with deep mucus that causes a cough and heavy nose drainage cannot function at school.
- Fever – fever is a warning that something is wrong. A child should remain at home for 24 hours after the fever is gone.
- Rash – a rash, spots or blotches on the skin can be the first sign of many illnesses.
- Keep your child home until your doctor says it is safe to return.
- Stomach Ache/Upset – a child who is vomiting or has diarrhea should be kept at home.

Medication

The end of the school year is drawing to an end.



Please make sure you stop by the office to pick up your child/children's medication on June 13th & 14th. At that time, you may also pick up the necessary medical forms for next school

year. Please also know that any medication not picked up by Friday, June 21st will be disposed of. The district does not allow for any medication to be stored over the summer.

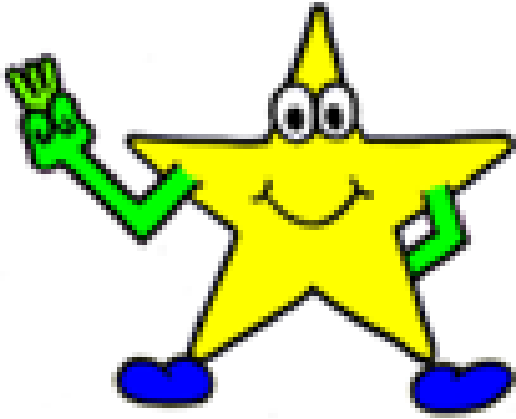

Creating a new account

Part 1:

1. Go to www.SendMoneyToSchool.com
2. Click on Create a new account
3. Provide requested information
4. Once you have read and agree with the terms of use click the I agree check box
5. Click the Create Account button
6. A confirmation email will be sent to you

Part 2:

7. Check your email
8. Click the provided link
9. Enter your email and password
10. Click the Login button
11. Start typing the name of your school district
12. When your district is displayed click on it
13. Click on the Add a student to your account button
14. Enter the student's ID number and click continue
15. If the ID number is valid you will be asked for your child's first name, last name and birthday
16. Once entered click the Add Student button
17. To add additional students click the Add a student to your account button again

3. All students assigned to this account will be displayed with their balances
4. To view history click the View Activity button next to the student's name
