Report Card Communication

During June, Beacon Tree will once again distribute reports cards electronically. The fourth marking period grades will be sent electronically to families at the end of the day on Friday, June 21, 2019.

To receive the report cards, parents will need to have a secure PowerSchool account. Parents who do not have access to a PowerSchool account will need to register for one prior to June 14, 2019. The report cards will then be automatically e-mailed to the address that is used to register the PowerSchool account.

If you already have a PowerSchool account, you do not need to take any further action. The report card will be automatically sent to you electronically.

Our school will no longer automatically print and mail report cards to parents.

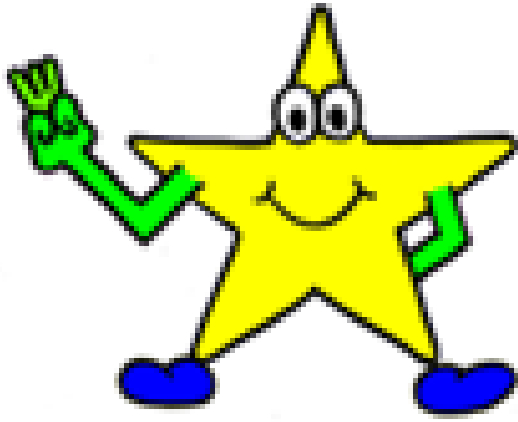
